



## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Associated Waste Management Ltd. is committed to the continual improvement of both external and internal environmental performance by means of effective environmental management. The Company shall implement an Integrated Management System, combining the requirements of an Environmental and Health & Safety Management System where applicable.

All steps shall be taken to ensure that our statutory duties are met at all times.

The Company recognises that to have a planned approach to the prevention and reduction of waste and pollution leads to a long term reduction of costs.

The Company shall control its activities to avoid unnecessary and unacceptable risks or adverse effects on the environment. Clients, employees and the general public who may be affected shall be made aware of any Company activity that may affect the environment.

Environmental awareness and individual responsibility shall be developed amongst employees at all levels and effective consultation shall be encouraged. The Company shall develop and improve standards by making use of available technology and developments, together with waste recovery and a recycle approach. Plant vehicles and equipment shall be maintained and operated to provide maximum environmental protection as far as is practical.

### ENVIRONMENTAL ACTION

Management shall take individual responsibility to ensure that environmental issues are considered when making decisions and when planning or controlling works.

### WORKFORCE

All employees must recognise their individual responsibilities for carrying out their works in a sympathetic manner with respect to the environment.

### WASTE REDUCTION

All employees must give careful consideration to the elimination and reduction of waste at every stage of the installation process.

Where recycling or re-use of material is an economical advantage this will be considered.

The Senior Management shall plan for the implementation of this policy, including setting achievable objectives and targets and establishing realistic key performance indicators. The objectives shall be audited regularly to monitor the company's achievements in its commitment to pollution prevention and continual improvement of environmental performance.
