



HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

Associated Waste Management Ltd. is committed to the continual improvement of occupational Health and Safety management and performance. It is our policy that operations shall be conducted in such a way as to ensure, so far as is reasonably practical, the health, safety and welfare of all our employees by adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our work activities and that our activities will not affect the health and safety of others. The Company shall implement an Integrated Management System, combining the requirements of a Health, Safety & Environmental Management System where applicable.

All steps shall be taken to ensure that our statutory duties are met at all times.

The policy of Associated Waste Management Ltd. is to ensure:

- Whilst working in occupied premises we will consult with our clients, advise of our work activities and ensure that those activities do not compromise our client's Health and Safety policy or cause risk to their employees or visitors
- High standards of Safety, Health and Welfare; this shall be achieved and maintained at all sites
- We provide and maintain safe plant and equipment and work systems suitable for the activity
- Materials and substances used in our work activities are safely handled and used
- Provide information, instruction, training and supervision as is necessary to ensure our employees and visitors are able to protect themselves and others
- We instigate such measures we consider appropriate to prevent accidents and cases of work related ill health
- Provide and maintain a safe and healthy working environment with safe access and egress
- Prior to commencing any work, we shall actively consult with employees on all matters concerning Health and Safety
- The Health & Safety policy shall be reviewed annually and monitored in order to meet the current legal requirements, codes of practice and improved working practices

The Senior Management shall plan for the implementation of this policy, including setting achievable objectives and targets and establishing realistic key performance indicators. The objectives shall be audited regularly to monitor the company's achievements in its commitment to accident prevention and continual improvement of safety performance. Health & Safety performance shall be monitored and reviewed to ensure that standards are maintained and improved.

This policy and other documents that support it, shall be brought to the attention of all Associated Waste Management Ltd. employees and others for whom the contents are relevant. The policy and supporting documentation shall be periodically reviewed.
